Moise Architectural Seminar

M.A.S. is a platform to share experience, ideas, desires, among faculties, fellows and candidates engaged in research about architectural design and theory.

The two sessions focus on two main aspects of research and dissemination.

In session 1, researchers make presentations of their work in journals, magazines, books, and other media: *Vesper*, *Villard Journal*, *Khorein Journal for Architecture and Philosophy*, *Fuoco amico*, *Ex libris*, etc. The participants discuss about writing, reading and publishing in architectural research.

In session 2, the focus is on research methodology. A series of short interventions, mostly of research fellows and PhD candidates, will explain a position, about methods and goals. The discussion will open a debate considering interactions with other disciplines, like history, philosophy, and others, and exploring the relationship between theory and design, in their multiple possible overlappings.

Session 3 sees a meeting with the responsible of the Center for Advanced Studies at University of Rijeka, DeltaLab and a visit of the city.

In the afternoon, the meeting gathers the inputs and contradictions emerged in the previous sessions to stimulate some conclusions and research projects.
